Pastoral Reflection

At the college where I minister, we have students who belong to a group whose job is to invite other students on campus to come to know Jesus Christ. They share their faith in concrete ways to fulfill Jesus' command: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15). Each person has unique gifts for building up the Church, the Body of Christ, and proclaiming the gospel. When we share those gifts, we do not stand around looking into the sky, like the disciples today. Filled with the power of the Holy Spirit, we evangelize. Our lives proclaim the joy of the gospel.

That will be sign enough that a relationship with Jesus Christ and his Church can transform the world, one person at a time.
