Pastoral Reflection

Preparing for our mission

Imagine being one of the disciples in today's gospel. You have just heard of Jesus' appearance on the road to Emmaus, which, along with the amazing story of the tomb, has given you a surge of hope. However, the grief and fear you felt during the crucifixion still remain in your heart. You want to believe that Jesus has risen as he said, but a pall of paralyzing uncertainty hangs over everything. Suddenly, he's in the room, standing right in front of you. Of course, he knows what you are feeling. "Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts?" he asks. "Touch me and see." You do see. Appearing before the disciples, Jesus gave them precisely what they needed for the next phase of their mission. He reassured and strengthened them by replacing their fear and uncertainty with peace and joy. He made the Scriptures intelligible to them so that they'd be able to pass on his wisdom. Why do fear and doubt arise in our hearts when Jesus calls us to something new? His death was the ultimate proof that his love for us knows no bounds. Just as prepared the disciples for their mission, so he will prepare us for ours.
